Field Trip Saturday, May 18

The field trip is planned for Saturday, May 18. All participants will gather at the Glade Park Store at 0900 hours. To get to the store, travel through the Colorado National Monument via the east entrance. After getting to the rim and immediately after the Cold Shivers view point there will be a sign (turn left) indicating the direction and distance to the store on DS Road. Tell the park ranger at the entrance gate that you are going to Glade Park and there will be no fee. It takes about forty-five minutes to get to the store from town.

All participants should wear clothing appropriate for a day in the country. It will probably be warm but rain is always possible. Most of the field trip stops will be on or nearby a road.

A vehicle with good clearance (e.g. SUV) is required, however four wheel drive is not necessary. There will be one or two short hike of less than a quarter mile where comfortable hiking shoes are recommended; tennis shoes OK. All should bring a **lunch**, **water**, **snacks and any personal items required**. Cameras are suggested as well as a **hat**, **sun block**, a **light jacket** or sweater. It probably will be warm; however, one never knows!
