Roundtrip Distance - Approximately 110 miles from Grand Junction.


Cost - None (donations to the Chenoweth Fund are encouraged). **Food** - None provided; bring your own lunch, snacks, water, etc.

- Subsurface data in UC (drilling and geophysical)
- Hypotheses for abandonment of UC
- Post abandonment sedimentary fill
- Pleistocene glaciation of Uncompangre Plateau and UC
- Economic geology (mineral deposits) of northeastern UC
- Ute Creek Graben
- Gateway gravels
- Cutler Formation
- Uravan Mineral Belt
- Human history of UC
